

INDIGENOUS RIGHTS

Clean Air Metals Inc. ("Clean Air Metals" or the "Company") (TSXV: AIR) (FRA: CKU) (OTCQB: CLRMF) and Fort William First Nation, Red Rock Indian Band, and the Biinjitiwaabik Zaaging Anishinaabek (collectively the "Cooperating Participants") jointly announce that they have advanced their relationship through a signed Memorandum of Agreement (the "MOA") effective as of January 8, 2021.

The MOA confirms a framework for a mutually beneficial relationship between the Cooperating Participants regarding the Project, based on the relationship set out in a November 2011 Memorandum of Agreement and Communication Protocol among the Cooperating Participants, which remains in effect. The MOA establishes a foundation for collaborative and respectful communications between the Cooperating Participants to facilitate Clean Air Metals' consultation with the Participating First Nations to identify:

- Potential impacts of the Project on the Participating First Nations interests and rights
- Appropriate measures to mitigate and avoid any adverse effects
- Opportunities to enhance positive impacts and benefits
