

EXCELLON MEXICAN OPERATIONS

COMMUNITY PROGRAMS DEVELOPED IN 2022

At the operational units in Platosa mine and Miguel Auza process plant, Excellon Resources' programs were focused to strengthen our ties to the communities of interest for our operations, with coverage in various areas such as Education, Health, Environmental Protection, Safety, Infrastructure Development, Sports, Art, and Culture. In calendar year 2022, Excellon's programs included the following efforts in the local communities:

ACTIVITIES

Education

 We delivered school furniture and material to the local educational centers such as Francisco Villa and Jose Vasconcelos Kindergarten, Centenario elementary school, Cobaed Robotic school, the Bermejillo Technical High School and the Autonoma de Zacatecas University.



- We renewed the agreement to support with fuel for the transportation of students from ejidos such as Sierrita, Nombre de Dios and February 22 to Cobaed, Bermejillo.
- We helped the Technical High school Number 15 with the maintenance of their technical equipment.



 During 2022, we also participated in Environmental awareness campaigns with most of the local elementary schools in the Bermejillo and Miguel Auza areas. In these campaigns we emphasized the importance of the rational use of water, the proper management and recycle of the solid urban waste and the importance of reforestation activities.



Health and Safety Communities:

 Our Health & Safety department organized and lead a fire safety community emergency response training. The company provide the participants with the knowledge and skills needed to reduce or eliminate fire hazards.



- Throughout 2022, we organized a campaign with preventive measures against covid 19, which we directed to our community.
- We held a drawing contest about how to improve the safety conditions in our units, all the children of Bermejillo and Miguel Auza towns participated.
- In October, both units in Mexico participated in a Breast Cancer Campaign.



The campaign's target audience were women ages 18 to 44, particularly those whose family history and backgrounds predispose them to a higher risk for breast cancer at a young age.

Traditions, Art and Culture:

- We were sponsors of the photographic exhibition of old weddings at the culture house of Bermejillo.
- As a company we also were sponsors of the 24K run in the local Mapimi and participated in the contest.



- We donated equipment to the local playgrounds in the area of Mapimi.
- In June our workers celebrated International Day of Women in Mining.



Institutional Development:

 Same as previous years, the company supported the local communities from Bermejillo and Miguel Auza, which were severely affected economically by the Covid 19 pandemic years, by donating groceries, non-perishable food, cleaning material and blankets donations.

• On the Mapimi town anniversary, the company donated cleaning supplies and equipment to the Mapimi government.



- We supported the Association of Businesswomen in Mapimi by celebrating Women's Day.
- Together with the Durango state government, we donated schools supplies and toys for the Mapimi town children.
